Automotive Lighting 101



- **Headlights** are powerful lights mounted to the front of your vehicle that help illuminate the roadway in front of you.
- **Fog lights** have a wider beam pattern and are mounted lower than headlights to help you see better in adverse conditions.
- **Signal lights** are brake, park and turn signal lights that help you communicate with other drivers.
- **Four headlight systems** use separate bulbs for the low beams and high beams.

Safer lighting means safer driving.

Dim or misaligned headlights can make night driving dangerous. These simple lighting tips from SYLVANIA can help make night driving safer.

- **Change your headlights in pairs, before they burn out.**

Most headlights dim over time. Replace yours about once a year for the brightest light.

- **Upgrade to whiter, brighter headlights.**

Headlights that produce a whiter, more natural color can improve your visibility and your reaction time.

- **Check your headlight alignment.**

Misaimed headlights can be distracting and dangerous. Ask your auto service technician to align them for you.

- **Clean your headlights regularly.**

Wash your headlights when you wash your windshield. You'll see better and help prevent glare.

- **Make sure all your vehicle lights are working.**

Have a friend turn on your headlights and signal lights while you walk around the outside of your vehicle.

Headlights dim over time.

SYLVANIA recommends replacing headlights in pairs about once a year. Annual replacement ensures that your headlights will always be their brightest.
